TITLE VI POLICY STATEMENT


Porter County government is committed to the nondiscrimination provisions of Title VI. No person shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, disability, religion, income status, Limited English Proficiency, or any other unlawful bias, be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity conducted by the recipient regardless of whether those programs are federally-funded or not.

Porter County will include the Title VI assurance language in all written agreements and bid notices and will monitor compliance.


